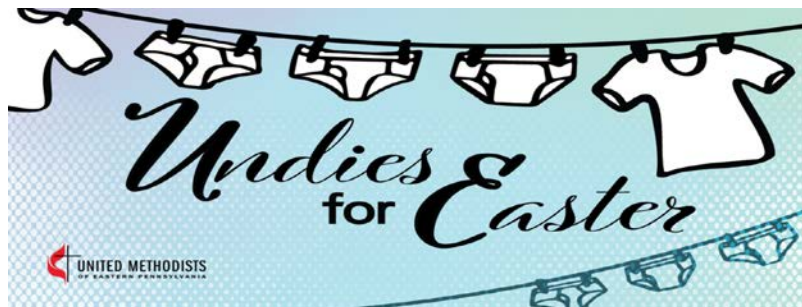


RENEWAL LEAVE
