ANGEL TREE EXTENDED ANOTHER WEEK!

The Angel Tree program has been extended through **Sunday, Nov. 27th** when the Angel Tree "elves" will sort, bag, and transport the gifts to the Center in time for families to select a gift for their own little patient.

You're invited to select an Angel, purchase a gift of a TOY for your chosen angel that is age appropriate, and return it under the tree. We ask that your gift be wrapped for Christmas, have a gift tag on the front (please leave it blank so parents may choose how to mark the tag!), and your white paper angel (that you will have listed what is contained in your gift on the bottom of the Angel's gown) taped to the back of the package. We will provide bows for packages when we deliver the gifts to the Osborn Center, so they are not crushed during transport to the facility!
